- 1 Perform psychological evaluation of pain patients.
- 2 Assess and manage functional status in pain patients.
- 3 Diagnose common chronic pain problems.
- 4 Identify appropriate patients for non-opioid and interventional therapies for chronic pain.
- 5 Offer more alternative medicine techniques and suggest supplements that may help with chronic pain.
- 6 Prescribe new pain medications with a better understating of drug-drug interactions.
- 7 Identify rheumatologic processes that have an effect on pain, and refer to rheumatology when appropriate.
- 8 Manage long-term pain medications, particularly opioids, when appropriate.
- 9 Utilize referral and ancillary care providers in treating chronic pain.
- 10 Conduct peer-to-peer discussions about pain patients with medical directors.
- 11 Communicate pain management principles with practitioners in other fields of medicine.
